My grandfather Bill Stevens raced on the Canadian Alpine Ski Team in the 1950's and competed in the World Championships in 1954 and 1958.

My Uncle Don Stevens also raced on the Canadian Alpine Ski Team. He was in the World Championships in 1985 and 1989, competed in the Calgary Olympics in 1988 and came second place in a World Cup Downhill in 1988 at Beaver Creek, Colorado.

Giving back: I recognize how fortunate I was to grow up ski racing. I am grateful for this opportunity and look for ways to give back. I enjoy helping out with the younger athletes, for example running the U14 dryland for Grouse Mountain Tyee Ski Club, and being a role model for younger ski racers.



2024-2025 Recap of Ski Season

Last season was the best of my ski racing career. I qualified for and competed in the **World Junior Ski Championships in Italy**, representing Canada on the world stage. I also raced a full **Nor-Am Cup circuit**, finishing **12th overall in Downhill** with consistent results across the series, including a **2nd place U21 finish** and multiple Top 15 placements.

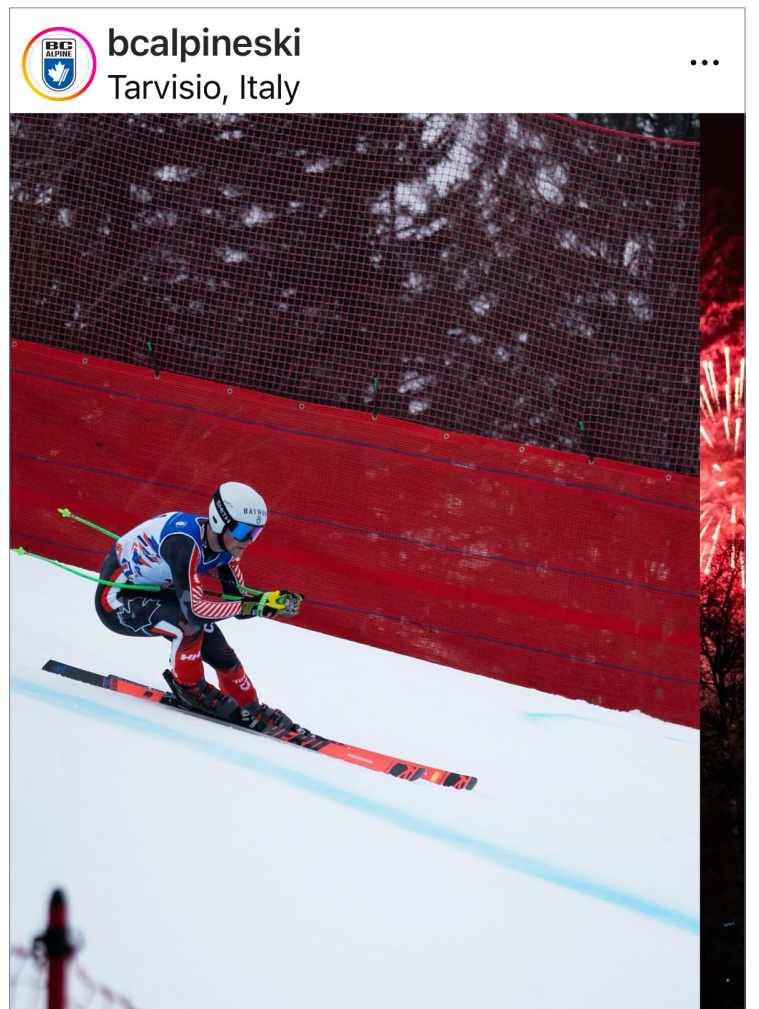
The season began with **dryland training in Fernie**, followed by an **on-snow camp in Chile** that prepared me for my first Nor-Am races in Panorama. I opened strong with a **16th and 12th place (2nd U21) in SG**, placing me **14th in the standings early on**.

Solid results in **Kimberley and Sugarloaf** helped me finish the season ranked **Top 15 in SG and 12th in DH**, meeting the **Provisional Nomination** criteria for the **CAST D Team**. Although I wasn't selected this year, I'm more motivated than ever.

I'm staying with the **BC Ski Team** and fully committed to qualifying next season through **Automatic Nomination** which is **Top 5 in a Nor-Am discipline**. With even more focused training and international competition ahead, I'm aiming to make that next step.
